WHAT IS THE AIM OF DRIVE PROJECT?

The general objective of this project is to contribute in the development of the research and innovation capacities of HEIs in Albania and Kosovo by enhancing their institutional capabilities, staff skills and networking.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

1. Presentation of The Gender Equality Plan and Code of Conduct and Ethics in Research

The Gender Equality Plan and Code of Conduct and Ethics in Research, as part of the results of the DRIVE project, were presented to a wide audience of researchers and academics from the Western Balkans and the EU, in the event held at University of Banja Luka in the framework of WBC_RRI.NET (Responsible Research and Innovation in the Western Balkans) on September 23, 2022. DRIVE project and the above results prepared by all the partners of the Consortium, were presented by the Coordinator Polis University, respectively the Vice Rector Dr. Elona Karafili, Project Manager Dr. Flora Krasniqi and General Director of NASRI Mrs. Mirela Muca, in the role of associate partner in the project.



2. "Hints and Tips on Research Project Funding" training, organized by the Office for Project Development and Internationalization of UET

On June 16, 2022, the Office for Project Development and Internationalization organized a training on research projects funding for the academic staff of the European University of Tirana, entitled "Hints and Tips on Research Project Funding". This training is organized within the framework of Erasmus+ KA2 projects, such as DRIVE, co-financed by the EU. 
3. Study visits and workshop in Hamburg, hosted by Technische Universität Hamburg

4. New teaching and learning methodologies implemented at Faculty of Electrical and Computer Engineering – University of Prishtina

On February 1, 2022 University of Prishtina, presented some samples of how new teaching methodologies, such as Project and Problembased-learning (PBL) introduced through DRIVE Erasmus+ Project are being implemented at BSc and MSc level courses at the Faculty of Electrical and Computer Engineering. During this training, students worked in groups or individually to solve particular problems or present projects within the scope of the course.
